

PHYSICAL ACTIVITY AND MENTAL HEALTH

It is proven by researchers that physical activity improves mental health by reducing anxiety, depression, and negative mood and by improving selfesteem and cognitive function

Research has shown that physical activity releases chemicals in your brain that make you feel good - boosting your self-esteem, helping you concentrate as well as sleep, look and feel better.

HOW CAN PHYSICAL ACTIVITY HELP MY MENTAL HEALTH?



BETTER SLEEP

By making you feel more tired at the end of the day.



HAPPIER MOODS

Physical activity releases feel-good hormones that make you feel better in yourself and give you more energy.



MANAGING STRESS, ANXIETY OR INTRUSIVE AND RACING THOUGHTS Doing something physical releases cortisol which helps us manage stress. Being physically active also give your brain something to focus on and can be a positive coping strategy for difficult times.



BETTER SELF-ESTEEM

Being more active can make you feel better about yourself as you improve and meet your goals.



REDUCING THE RISK OF DEPRESSION Studies have shown that doing regular physical activity can reduce

he likelihood of experiencing a period of depression.



CONNECTING WITH PEOPLE

Doing group or team activities can help you meet new and like-minded people, and make new friends.

WHAT IS WELLBEING?

The government defines wellbeing as 'a positive physical, social and mental state'. Mental wellbeing does not have a single universal definition, but it does encompass factors such as:

The sense of feeling good about ourselves and being able to function well individually or in relationships





with challenges and making the most of opportunities

Having control and freedom over our lives

The feeling of connection to our community and surroundings

Of course, mental wellbeing does not mean being happy all the time, and it does not mean that you won't experience negative or painful emotions, such as grief, loss or failure, which are a part of normal life. However, whatever your age, being physically active can help you to lead a mentally healthier life and can improve

WHAT IMPACT DOES PHYSICAL **ACTIVITY HAVE ON WELLBEING?**

Physical activity has a huge potential to enhance our wellbeing. Even a short burst of 10 minute's brisk walking increases our mental alertness, energy and positive mood
